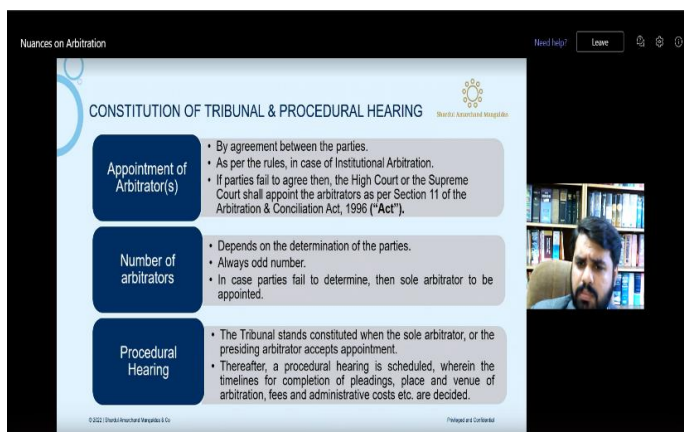

DRAFTING OF STATEMENT OF DEFENCE & COUNTER CLAIM

Shardul Amarchand Mangaldas

- SOD&CC is document whereby a Respondent pleads his defence to the averments and claims raised by the Claimant, and also mounts his Counter-claims against the Claimant, if any. Counter-claims are independent and separable from the claims.
- Contents of SOD:
 - Cause Title
 - Introduction of the parties – an individual, a company, partnership, SPV, etc.
 - Scheme of the Contract – Respondent's interpretation of purpose/objective of the Contract and key obligations of the parties.
 - Preliminary Submissions:
 - Breach-wise points of defence.
 - Claimant's breaches, if any.
 - Legality of termination of contract, if any.
 - Response to claims – entitlement and/or quantification
 - Para-wise Responses – Denials with cogent reasons and references to preliminary submissions.
 - Counter Claims – Entitlement and Quantification
 - Reliefs
