## E-Summit '20

E-Summit '20 was the first ever Corporate Flagship event organized by the Entrepreneurship Cell of NMIMS, Navi Mumbai, the beginning of a legacy that is likely to inspire many more in the days to come.

The event, spanning over two days, on the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> of February, 2020 aimed to provide a conducive platform for students – who are aspiring to be entrepreneurs- to understand, learn, envision and explore the idea of revolutionizing the world, finding solutions to the problems plaguing our world today and prepare for what may come up in the future. The E-Cell firmly believes in the power of dialogue, debate and discussion to deliver education based on practical and real-time simulation of the business environment as we know it.

The 2-day summit commenced with the inaugural event where the welcome address was delivered by Dr. P. N. Mukherjee, Director, NMIMS – Navi Mumbai campus. It also included key-note speeches by the Chief Guest – Mr. Kapil Dev, Executive Vice President – National Commodity and Derivatives Exchange Ltd. (NCDEX) and the Guest of Honour – Mr. Sanjay Goel, Chairman– GTC Group. While Mr. Goel spoke candidly of his journey as an entrepreneur with important lessons of humility and foresight and anecdotes from his own personal experiences, Mr. Kapil Dev delivered an eye-opening speech about the agrarian crisis India. He also shared the inspiring tale of how our farmers produce food, sustaining the most adverse of conditions subjected to them. Both of them stressed on the need for initiative and drive amongst the youth in the country and expressed multiple times the weight of responsibility that we must deliver.

He also enlightened the audience of the stark differences between a corporate job and a self-owned business, the many sacrifices to be made and patience required to execute your plans to reality. His humility and perseverance left everyone inspired to just go the extra mile to make a difference.
